A late 19th century French ormolu and Sèvres style porcelain mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the backplate detailed 'Woppenhein Paris', the circular enamel dial with blue Roman hour numerals and outer black Arabic minutes, inscribed 'Mueller 23, Edgware Rd London', the drum case with female bust surmount above flower swags, helmet, quiver birds and shield, on a breakfront base with toupie feet, height 35cm, with later pendulum and giltwood stand.

Condition Report

1146. Generally good condition. Typical wear to ormolu and a bit dusty and dirty, but no significant damage or repairs. Dial is good and clean. Glazed convex doors to front and back are in good order with sound hinges. The movement winds smoothly and starts to run, and strike mechanism is working as it should, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
