A late 19th/early 20th century French brass cased mantel clock, the eight day movement with platform escapement striking hours and half hours on a gong, the silvered dial with foliate boss centre, the case with swing handle above stepped top and reeded columns, on bracket feet, height 22cm.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1113. The case is very dirty and worn, but otherwise ok with no missing parts. Silvered dial also worn. Glass door to front in good order. Hinges to both front and back doors are good and close tightly. Movement winds smoothly and runs for a few seconds before stopping. Strike mechanism working with hour striking and strike on half hour. We would suggest a service would return movement to full working order.
