A late 19th century French gilt spelter and Sèvres style porcelain mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the porcelain circular dial with black Roman hour numerals on a pink and gilt band, the centre painted with bird and flowers, indistinctly inscribed, the case with urn surmount above cast shell mask and foliate scrolls, inset with similarly decorated porcelain panels to front and side panels, the case back stamped 'P.H Mourey 73', height 44cm, with pendulum.

Condition Report

1115. The clock is in generally good condition, but is a bit dusty and dirty. Porcelain panels appear to be in good order, but some surface scratches and wear to painting and gilt. Back door opens and closes tightly. The movement winds smoothly and runs, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The strike mechanism also in working order.

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
