A Continental porcelain Chelsea style diminutive figural scent bottle and stopper, late 19th century, modelled as a shepherd with shears and a sheep, underglaze blue crowned 'N' mark to base, height 8.3cm, together with a small group of toy china, including a Royal Worcester floral painted mug, circa 1886 (faults and restoration).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

Figural scent - missing half of one blue flower applied to reverse of bottle - otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Royal Worcester mug - crazing to glaze and wear to gilding.

Royal Crown Derby mug - extensively restored.

Blue ground mug - gilding worn, otherwise ok.

Imari cup and saucer - saucer crazed, some wear.

Three floral cups and saucers - one in good condition, other two extensively restored.

Pair cups and saucers - one cup repaired and missing handle, other pieces ok.

Two handled cup and saucer - cup cracked, saucer ok.

Two Toby jugs - both crazed, one with extensive chipping to foot.
