A New Hall porcelain part service, circa 1790, pattern No. 89, painted with a gilt and magenta chain border, comprising teapot and cover, jug, sugar bowl and cover, two plates, diameter 19cm, slop bowl, ten saucers, ten teabowls and four coffee cups (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

Teapot - badly cracked, small chip to underside rim edge of cover.

Sugar - badly cracked, cover ok.

Jug - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Gilding rubbed.

Slop - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Plates - one with large section of rim broken away in two pieces and visibly glued with minor chipping along the rim edge of the repaired section. Other plate generally ok, both with minor typical surface scratches/wear.

Saucers - all in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Coffee cups - all in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Teabowls - all in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
