An amber flashed Bohemian glass engraved jar and cover, 19th century, the hexagonal U-shaped body with a titled view of 'The Bank of the United States, Philadelphia', after Hermann J. Meyer, within trellis framing, raised on a waisted stem and scalloped petal foot, the domed cover with engraved trellis detail, height 33cm, (rim repaired), together with a small group of Continental glasses, including a roemer, dated 1751, a sepia enamelled Lobmeyr beaker and a pair of glasses with Krautstrunk style decoration (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

1724. Two large chips to the rim of the amber jar, each approx 10cm wide with an amateur glued repair, several further small chips to cover and foot. One conical glass lacks gilt to the engraving. One clear glass beaker has a glued repair to the foot. General age related wear.
