LOT 1455

A mixed group of miniature porcelain table and decorative wares, mostly early 19th century, including an Imari Mason's Patent Ironstone teapot and cover, length 10cm, a Chamberlains Worcester blue ground floral painted vase, height 5.5cm, a pair of bottle vases and covers and a jug and basin (some faults and restoration).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Imari Mason's teapot and cover - restoration to spout, minor hairline to rim by handle, minor typical surface wear to enamels and gilding.

Similar cobalt blue teapot and cover - minor chip to exterior edge of foot, triangular shaped chip to rim where cover sits, sizeable chip to edge of cover, minor typical surface wear.

Green ground teapot - spout detached but available with the lot, small chip to tip of spout, handle broken in two places and repaired, heavily crazed overall, chip to underside edge of cover and side of knop.

Blue ground jug with high handle - handle professionally restored.

Chamberlains Worcester floral painted flared circular bowl - badly cracked.

Gaudy Welsh jug - heavily crazed but ok.

Green ground vase and cover - professional restoration to rim, chipping to edge of cover.

Basket - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Blue ground jug - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Pair blue ground vases and covers - one with restoration to top of neck and cover permanently fixed in place, other with vertical cracks to neck.

Green ground jug and basin - wear to gilding and enamels otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Coalport teapot - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Two blue ground trumpet vases - one marked Chamberlains Worcester with small glazed over manufacturing flaw to rim, some crazing to both.

Chinoiserie jug - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Floral jug and basin - jug heavily crazed, otherwise in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Blue ground flared bowl - crazed with scratches to interior.

Group of two birds - one bird missing tail.
