A small group of decorative ceramics, late 19th century and later, including a pair of Staffordshire pottery spill vases, modelled as a ram and sheep, height 13.5cm, a pair of Staffordshire models of zebra, a Royal Copenhagen otter, No. 2333, and a Jean Gille white glazed bust, entitled 'Hiver'.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

Ram and sheep - left ear of sheep professionally restored, ram extensively badly cracked through base with bad chipping to right ear and enamel flaking to base.

Zebras - facing right in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. Facing left extensively restored.

Pair greyhounds - both heavily crazed, one with chipped nose other with repair to extended part of face.

Toby - fine vertical hairline to rim and crazed, otherwise ok.

Imari jug - badly cracked and chipped.

Otter - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Dog - light surface wear, otherwise ok.

Bust - approx 4cm long noticeable chip to back edge of footrim, two minor chips amidst folds of headscarf, otherwise ok.
