A rare large Wedgwood pottery jardinière, 1930s, painted by Alfred Powell, monogrammed, the U-shaped body with four landscape panels within blue and green foliate framing, edged in blue and white chequered bands, impressed factory marks to base with blue painted monogram and numerals '3972', height 32.5cm.

Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The glaze displays some crazing primarily to the interior.

The jardinière must have been used to house a plant pot at some stage as the base interior and interior sides are scratched with some minor rust spots and light staining amidst the glaze crazing.
