A Staffordshire or Northern England slipware baking dish, mid to late 18th century, of rounded rectangular shape with piecrust rim, trailed and combed in brown slip on a cream ground, length 40.5cm (areas of glaze loss), together with a pair of later slipware baking dishes, length 26.5cm (minor chips).

Large dish - no cracks, chips or restoration, but considerable glaze loss/flaking to the surface of the dish overall - please see the extra images on our website using the zoom function.

Two other dishes - both with some chipping to the upper rim edge, no cracks or restoration.
