### LOT 1422

A pair of Mintons pottery plates from the Anacreon series, 1870s, designed by John Moyr Smith, impressed marks to bases, diameter 25.5cm, together with a similar brown printed Snowdrop plate by Moyr Smith, diameter 22cm, a Wileman Foley china plate, decorated with pixies, designed by Vulliamy, diameter 23.5cm, and a small group of other tablewares, including a Minton Society of Arts Prize Pattern teacup and saucer (minor faults).

Estimate: £70 - £100

### Condition Report

Pair Anacreon plates - both heavily crazed, one with two haircracks to rim, each with flaking/wear to the ochre banding.

Snowdrop plate - heavily crazed with indistinct starcrack to underside.

Pixies plate - some surface scratches and wear to gilt rim.

Cup and saucer - haircrack to lower handle terminal, saucer well scratched.

Pink ground plate - surface scratched with light staining.

Queen Victoria plate - crazed, chip to underside rim edge.

Holly plate - broken in half and riveted.

3 'Gothic' plates - each display wear caused by heavy use.
