### LOT 1608

An English Delft charger, probably Bristol, mid-18th century, painted in blue with a chinoiserie garden, the rim with four floral groups, diameter 30.5cm, together with three other Delft chargers, including one painted in blue with a house, diameter 33.7cm, and one in Kraak style, and two English Delft plates, diameter 23cm (faults and restoration).

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

Chinoiserie garden charger - sizeable chip to rim at 10 o'clock, otherwise typical fritted chips.

Dish with house - large glued repair and extensive chipped fritting.

Kraak style dish - broken into a large number of pieces and visibly repaired with some filling along the break lines.

Ochre rimmed dish - badly cracked with chips and fritting to rim.

Plate with house - amateur filling to most of rim circumference.

Plate with garden - actually Chinese - crack to rim at 5 and 11 o'clock, extensive chipping to rim edge.
