## LOT 535

A platinum and diamond cluster ring, mounted with seven principal circular cut diamonds within a surround of smaller circular cut diamonds between split shoulders, London 2001, fitted with two sizing beads, weight 6g, ring size approx G, with a case.

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

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## Condition Report

Unfortunately we unable to provide a professional grading of the diamonds.

The principal seven diamonds under x10 magnification have one or two inclusions which are white in colour, but these are not noticeable to the unaided eye. The stones are bright and sparkling, with a pleasant display of fire overall.

The surrounding diamonds look to have one or two inclusions under x10 magnification.

Due to the nature of the setting it is difficult to ascertain with any certainty the approximate carat weight.

Face-up the principal diamonds might be 0.15ct each, the surrounding diamonds are less than 0.03ct each.

Overall the total carat weight may be just over 1.00ct.

There is some thinning and typical surface wear to the shank.

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
