A pair of German wine glasses, mid to late 18th century, the ogee bowls with bubbles to the solid bases, above baluster stems and domed feet, heights 18cm and 18.3cm, together with a group of mostly Continental glass wines, including a wrythen moulded example with folded foot and 'Eales Collection' label to base, and a sweetmeat with shell bowl, height 12.5cm.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

One opaque twist stem glass with minor fracture to edge of foot.

Sweetmeat with cover with chip to top rim edge of bowl.

Otherwise the lot is in good condition overall.
