A 'Jacobite' rummer, early 19th century, the flared conical bowl engraved with a rose in bloom and two buds on a leafy stem, an oak leaf and a thistle beneath 'FIAT', on a lemon squeezer foot, height 9.5cm (minor chips to foot), together with two faceted stem wine glasses and a plain stem glass.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

'Jacobite' glass - glued repair to stem, possibly a replacement foot? The square base of the lemon squeezer with chips and possible reduction.

Larger faceted stem glass - minute nick to edge of foot.

Smaller faceted stem glass - minute nick to rim.

Plain stem - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.
