A 17th century ebonized and red stained tortoiseshell collector's cabinet, the top and sides with bone line inlaid borders, fitted with a central cupboard enclosing three drawers within an arrangement of ten further oak-lined drawers, all with applied Dutch ripple mouldings, height 47.5cm, width 73cm, depth 39cm (faults), together with a late Victorian ebonized table stand.

### Condition Report

2190 - Losses to veneer in places. Lacking escutcheons and locks. Lacking front panel. Base is associated and late 19th century. Lacking key, so bottom middle drawer is locked shut. 6 pieces of moulding around the drawers missing. One further piece detached but present. Heavy age related wear throughout.
