A set of four George III silver Corinthian column candlesticks, each with a beaded detachable nozzle above a swagged sconce and vertical beaded and reeded tapering stem, on a beaded and bellflower stepped square base, Sheffield 1780 by John Winter & Co, height 29.5cm.

Condition Report

440. The set is in generally good condition.

The candlesticks are filled and not solid silver. Dent to corner of nozzle and top of Corinthian column capital on one stick and two further dents to two corners of the Corinthian capital on one other stick. All four candlesticks have numerous very small dents to the bases and minor age related marks. Each engraved to the base with shield shaped crest.

All hallmarks matching to all sticks and nozzles.
