LOT 560

A late Victorian 18ct gold and diamond two stone ring, designed as two entwined snakes, mounted with two cushion cut diamonds, London 1893, weight 7.2g, ring size approx M1/2.

Estimate: £220 - £280

Condition Report

The diamonds slightly draw colour, one diamond has a vertical inclusion, the other diamond looks to be more clear.

The ring has been resized at the back in the past.

Maker's mark no longer apparent, the remaining hallmark is clear.

Solder repair visible within the shank by one of the snake's heads.

Diamond size approximately 3mm x 3mm, measurement limited by setting.

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
