A gold and sardonyx shield shaped signet ring, last quarter of the 19th century, crest engraved, the mount with decorated shoulders, unmarked, weight 6.3g, ring size approx L, and a Georgian gold and garnet eternity ring, mounted with foil backed garnets, unmarked, weight 1g, ring size approx L (several garnets missing).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Sardonyx signet ring - slight chipping at the top of the sardonyx, otherwise general overall wear. Some traces of sealing wax within the intaglio. Mount is a little worn, with some loss of definition of design. Shank a little thin at the back and has been resized in the past.

Garnet eternity - ten garnets are lacking. The remaining garnets have rubbing to the facet edges. Ring mount is showing signs of wear. The ring is unmarked. No evidence of solder repair to either ring.

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
