A Barnet Henry Joseph gold, amethyst and white enamelled necklace, first quarter of the 20th century, the front fitted with a row of seven graduated drops, each centred by a collet set cushion cut amethyst within a white enamelled openwork surround, detailed 'B.H.J. 9ct', on a trace link neckchain with a boltring clasp, weight 8.9g, length 37.5cm.

Estimate: £200 - £250

Condition Report

Overall would benefit from cleaning.

One or two small chips to the enamel. Some of the links are starting to look a little worn.

Slight variation of colour to the amethysts, the second from one end is rather pale.

Clasp in working order.

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
