A gold, ruby and half-pearl set necklace, first quarter of the 20th century, the front with a central bow motif between floral and foliate sides, on a trace link neckchain with a boltring clasp, unmarked, weight 15g, length 47cm, with an associated case.

Estimate: £600 - £900

Condition Report

The rubies are of pale colour saturation. The pearls have slight variation of lustre. One pearl is lacking from the top of the bow, another from the linen-fold drop to the right of this. The linen-drop on the opposite side is lacking a pearl also.

Some pearls may have been replaced in the past. The boltring clasp is in working order. The neckchain is likely a replacement.
