LOT 675

A gold, sapphire and diamond ring, early 20th century, mounted with three cushion cut diamonds alternating with two cushion cut sapphires, with four pairs of rose cut diamonds at intervals, detailed '18', weight 4.3g, ring size approx N1/2.

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

Condition Report

Sapphires of medium colour saturation. Some minor abrasion to the table facet edges of both stones. Under x10 magnification there is some colour zoning but otherwise the sapphires do not appear to have any significant inclusions.

The three principal diamonds are attractive bright white stones.

The largest diamond has a surface reaching inclusion to one side of the table and there is a surface chip below a claw near here also.

One side diamond has a surface reaching inclusion running across the edge of the table.

Some wear to a few of the claws. No evidence of resizing. Some thinning to the back of the shank.

Stone size approximate and limited by setting:

centre diamond approx. 5mm x 5mm

sapphires approx. 4.5mm x 4.5mm

side diamonds approx. 3mm x 3mm

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
