A pair of early George III silver sauceboats, each with a gadrooned rim flanked by a foliate capped scroll handle, raised on a shaped oval gadrooned foot, London 1765 by William Skeen, weight 1013g, height 16.5cm.

Condition Report

480. Both sauceboats a little worn and tired with surface scratches and wear to high points in particular. Both with engraved crest, both with good clear hallmarks.

One with small split to rim just to the side of handle and lower part of handle pushed into the body slightly. Few minor dents to body.

The other with small lead repairs to body at junction with handle and to underside of body just above the foot. Numerous small dents.
