A George III silver circular bread basket with overhead ropetwist swing handle, the pierced sides formed with reeded basketweave between a stiff leaf basal band and chased basketweave rim, the interior engraved with a coat of arms, the underside with engraved presentation inscription 'Given to G.E. Beauchamp by the Heirs of George Caswall Esq of Sacomb Park Herts 1828', London 1792 by John Wakelin & William Taylor, weight 1241g, diameter 27.2g, height including handle 28.5cm.

Condition Report

450. The basket is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Good definition to decoration and high points with only typical minor surface scratches and wear. Minor misshaping in places to the basketweave, but nothing of any great significance. Engraved armorial to base is slightly rubbed, but still clear. Handle is part marked with lion passant, hallmarks to underside are clear, engraved presentation inscription to base as well.
