A set of eight late 19th/early 20th century Chinese silver salts, each in the form of a two-handled basket, height 3.5cm, with six bamboo effect wirework stands and seven salt spoons, and a set of three Chinese silver hexagonal salts, decorated in relief with panels of flowers, bamboo and characters, total weight 314g, together with a group of various condiment spoons.

Condition Report

479. All pieces in generally good order, but would benefit from a clean.

Eight basket salts - good condition with typical minor wear and minor misshaping to handles.

Six stands - good order with only minor misshaping.

Three hexagonal salts - good condition, typical minor scratches and wear.

Spoons with minor misshaping, one with broken handle.

All salts are marked, stands and spoons are not marked.
