### LOT 510

A gold, ruby and diamond ring, early 20th century, mounted with three cushion cut diamonds alternating with two oval cut rubies, with four pairs of rose cut diamonds at intervals, unmarked, weight 3.2g, ring size approx N1/2.

Estimate: £500 - £700

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### Condition Report

Diamonds are fairly bright stones, if not drawing colour lightly to grey. Under x10 magnification they look to have one or two tiny inclusions. One side diamond has a chip to the girdle. The larger ruby appears to be fairly clear internally. The smaller ruby has a few noticeable inclusions to the unaided eye.

Some wear to the side of the mount. Some claws re-tipped in the past. Minor thinning to the shank.

All measurements are approximate and limited by the setting:

principal diamond approx. 4.5mm x 4.5mm

side diamonds approx. 3.5mm x 3.5mm

rubies approx. 3.5mm x 4.5mm and 3.5mm x 4mm

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
