LOT 691

An 18ct gold, diamond and emerald three stone ring, circa 1910, mounted with a cushion cut diamond between two emeralds, the mount decorated with scrolled sides, weight 2.5g, ring size approx K1/2.

Estimate: £140 - £180

Condition Report

Emeralds generally worn stones, facet edges difficult to make out, they typically have a number of inclusions. The emeralds are of pale to medium colour saturation.

The diamond appears to be a bright white stone face-up, slightly yellow tinted side-on. It has a surface reaching inclusion to a kite facet. A couple of long inclusions on one side evident under x10 magnification. A black inclusion below a star facet.

Claws worn in places and will need re-tipping.

Some thinning to the shank, particularly at the back. There is some wear to the side of the setting.

Measurements are approximate and limited by setting:

diamond - 4mm x 4mm

emeralds - 3.5mm x 2.5mm and 3mm x 2.5mm

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
