A Victorian gold mounted oval shell cameo brooch, carved as a portrait of a lady wearing a hat within a foliate engraved surround, unmarked, weight 14.6g, width 4.4cm, with a case, together with a gilt metal mounted micromosaic bracelet, each oval micromosaic designed as a differing classical building, on a snap clasp, length 17cm.

Condition Report

Bracelet

One panel is lacking a small section of the sky. The other micromosaics centres are generally in good condition. The rims of the micromosaic panels do have a few nicks and/or small chips generally. The panel with the small section of sky lacking has a few more noticeable scratches and scuffing to the black surround. The nicks/chips also more evident on the panel attached to the clasp.

Gilding is largely worn away. The clasp is in good working order. Slight wear between the links but no obvious signs of gluing or repair.

Cameo

Re-glued on one side running vertically up the cameo. The mount is generally in good condition.
