## LOT 670

A gold and amethyst bangle, circa 1920, carved as a scarab beetle, the shoulders decorated in the classical Egyptian taste, unmarked, total weight 15.2g, unextended inside width 6.1cm.

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## Condition Report

Generally the carving to the amethyst is quite worn, with general light scratching and rubbing to the high points. Small old chip to the underside of the amethyst on one edge. The amethyst is slightly loose in the setting.

The bangle itself is ever so slightly misshaped, with one or two tiny dents. The sizing mechanism works smoothly. Would benefit from a clean.

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
