Myatt & Co, height 3.7cm, a silver model of a teddy bear seated with a honey pot and spoon on a rectangular simulated carpet base, London 1992 by JR, height 2cm, and two .925 silver menu holders, one in the form of an elephant, the other of a deity, both on circular domed bases, heights 2.7cm and 3cm.
