LOT 1050

A pair of Chinese famille rose porcelain octagonal bowls and stands, 19th century, each facet painted with a scene of a figure in a garden setting, within turquoise 'Y' diaper and floral-filled iron red borders, height of bowl 8cm, width of stand 19.8cm (one bowl with restoration to rim, otherwise minor faults).

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

1050. Bowl 1 - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Tiny chip to glaze on rim, otherwise no other chips or cracks. Enamels are bright and vibrant with only typical surface scratches and wear. Some minor losses to blue enamels on rocks. Wear to gilt rim.

Bowl 2 - restoration and overpainting to two corners of the rim, so the overpainted area covers three facets of the rim and a total length of approx 12cm. The overpainting/restoration was done some time ago as it has turned a cream colour so is now more noticeable. Otherwise no cracks or chips. Typical surface scratches and wear. Minor loss to blue rock enamels. Wear to gilt on rim.

Stand 1 - small chip (0.5cm x 0.8cm) to corner of rim, otherwise generally good condition with good vibrant enamels. No cracks or repairs. Wear to gilt on rim. Surface wear to some of interior. Typical surface scratches to glaze and enamels.

Stand 2 - generally good condition with a few minor glaze scuffs/chips to the rim. Wear to gilt rim. No cracks or repairs. Good vibrant enamels but with some wear to bowl interior.
