A Chinese kesi weave dragon robe, Qing dynasty, decorated with eight five-clawed dragons chasing flaming pearls amidst vapours, bats and Buddhist emblems on a blue ground, above crashing waves and diagonally striped hem border, the silk embroidered striped cuffs worked in polychrome threads with figures, birds and flowers, fitted with gilt metal fastenings, length 136cm (some minor faults).

Condition Report

1200. The robe is in generally good condition with good vibrant colours. However, there are some small areas of wear and fraying, and some small holes scattered over the robe. Silk cuffs also worn and fraying along edges. Lining with some wear.

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
