A Chinese Dowager Empress Cixi style porcelain vase, Guangxu period, the shouldered tapering body and flared neck painted with dragons amidst peonies and chrysanthemums on a turquoise ground, within yellow banded borders filled with famille rose bird and flower vignettes, flowers and scrolling tendrils, height 37cm (chip and hairline to rim).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1014. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Small chip to side of rim (approx 1.7cm x 1.5cm), and a 3cm hairline running vertically down the rim from the chip. Otherwise typical surface scratches and wear to gilt and glaze, but colours are good and vibrant.
