A Japanese Satsuma earthenware bowl by Ryozan of Kobe, Meiji period, of wide elliptical form, the exterior painted and gilt with a band of variously shaped panels of figures, flowers and landscapes, the interior filled with goldfish beneath a simulated brocade rim, gilt signature to base, length 14.5cm, height 9.4cm (minor rim restoration).

1193. Minor restoration to rim. Typical light crazing. Typical wear to gilt, particularly on the rim. Some slight pink staining to the glaze, more visible on the underside of the exterior.
