A Chinese celadon crackle glazed porcelain bottle vase, Qing dynasty, the globular body and slightly waisted cylindrical neck covered in a celadon glaze, suffused with a network of grey and iron oxide crackles, height 40cm (damaged rim and neck).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1179. The upper 7cm section of the neck and rim have been badly damaged and partially repaired with some pieces chipped out and missing. Restoration to neck required. Otherwise the rest of the neck and body are in generally good condition with typical minor surface scratches to glaze.
