A Japanese Satsuma earthenware vase, Meiji period, painted and gilt with opposing figural scenes, height 32cm, together with three Chinese blue and white porcelain plates (some faults).

Condition Report

1257. Satsuma vase - generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs. Wear to gilt and enamels. Typical crazing to glaze and minor discolouration/staining. Some firing cracks visible to interior.

18th century blue and white plate - minor rim chips and 4.5cm hairline to rim. Typical light surface scratches to glaze.

19th century blue and white prunus border plate - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light surface scratches to glaze.

Other 19th century blue and white plate - chip and few minor nicks to rim. Star crack running approx 8cm across base. Typical scratches to glaze.
