A Japanese Satsuma earthenware vase, Meiji period, the swollen cylindrical body thickly enamelled and gilt with a bird and flowers in a landscape, beneath a flared neck filled with precious objects, gilt two-character mark above stylized iron red gourd shaped signature panel to side, height 12.5cm, together with a Japanese pottery gourd shaped vase with cream slip decoration on an oatmeal glazed ground, height 11.5cm.

### Condition Report

1092 - Satsuma vase - Good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Typical light crazing to glaze. Slightly more pronounced and minor staining to rim. Gilt and enamels bright and vibrant with only minor wear.

Other vase - Generally good condition with only tiny nick to rim, but no significant damage or repairs.
