A Japanese Satsuma earthenware cylindrical jar and cover, Meiji period, the body painted and gilt with a continuous scene of figures in a landscape, the cover with seated boy musicians, unsigned, height 19.4cm.

Condition Report

1093 - The jar and cover are in generally good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs, but the body glaze is discoloured/stained. Very minor nicks/chips to inner rim of the jar but not obviously noticeable. Typical light crazing to glaze and minor wear to gilt and enamels.
