### LOT 563

A gold mounted black moire ribbon dress fob, fitted with a boltring, detailed '9c', and a swivel, unmarked, total weight 7.5g, length 15.5cm, three enamelled buckles, a flat cut garnet cluster stickpin, a turquoise, seed pearl and gem set stickpin, an Indian oval glazed miniature painting depicting a temple scene and a small group of other jewellery.

Estimate: £80 - £120

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### Condition Report

Moire ribbon fob - in good condition

Enamelled studs - one has an acid stain to the back, they are gold plated, one is lacking its back fitting.

Enamelled buckle with scarab - in good condition but is rather crude. Other two buckles have damage to the enamel.

Coral earring - has some surface reaching flaws

Smaller garnet stickpin - central seed pearl needs replacing

Turquoise, garnet stickpin - was probably originally part of a ring

Indian miniature - the picture is in good condition, looks to have been resin filled at the back, the resin is now showing signs of cracking

Circular ceramic brooch - lacking pin

Two pairs of earrings - in good condition
