A gold and diamond cluster ring, mounted with the principal cushion cut diamond within a surround of eight smaller cushion cut diamonds, with rose cut diamond set shoulders, unmarked, weight 2.7g, ring size approx M1/2.

Estimate: £350 - £450

Condition Report

Unfortunately we cannot provide a professional grading of the diamonds.

The principal diamond has one or two tiny inclusions. Some variation of cut of the surrounding diamonds. The diamonds do have one or two internal gletz and pique inclusions. The diamonds look to be attractive white stones.

It is possible that there was once enamelled decoration to the shoulders of the ring, which is now lacking. Carat of gold is probably better than 9ct, perhaps 15ct.

Total carat weight approx. 0.60ct.

Some of the claws would benefit from re-tipping. Otherwise is quite good condition.
