LOT 700

A Victorian gold brooch of coiled form with applied bead and wirework decoration, the centre with a drop designed as a twin handled classical urn, weight 13.6g, width 4.4cm, and a matching pair of oval earrings, each with a replacement base metal screw fitting, weight 14.9g, length 4cm.

Estimate: £700 - £900

Condition Report

Brooch - the pin is lacking. There is a hook positioned at the back which may have held a drop in the past, which is no longer present.

Earrings- they have replacement base metal screw fittings, the back of the top of one of the urns is detailed '16'. Two acid stain marks to the three pieces. The earrings have small circular loops to the tops which may have held the original fittings, which may have been wires.

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
