A Victorian gold, citrine, garnet and red gem set brooch in a foliate scroll pierced design, mounted with a large oval cut citrine to the centre, unmarked, weight 11.3g, width 4.8cm, and a gold and seed pearl brooch, circa 1900, in a star shaped design, detailed '15', weight 8.2g, width 3.1cm

Estimate: £600 - £900

Condition Report

Citrine and garnet brooch - two areas of glue deposit when viewed from the back holding the frame of the citrine into position. Two further deposits of glue or lead solder holding one flowerhead motif into position. The hinge pin and hook in good condition. Otherwise there are one or two splits to the gold work. There are other repairs and damage evident. It is possible that there is a missing drop which would have been held by the loop at the bottom of the brooch.

Seed pearl brooch - the pin screw will no longer unthread and is soldered into position. The hook will still hinge. It is likely that some of the seed pearls are replaced.

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
