A Victorian gold neckchain in a plaited interwoven design, unmarked, with a boltring clasp, detailed '9K', weight 16.9g, length 49cm, a matching shorter length of gold chain, unmarked, weight 3.7g, length 6.5cm, and a gold mounted banded agate intaglio fob seal, carved as a portrait of lady, unmarked, fitted with a split ring, total weight 7.6g, together with a Victorian gilt metal cased bloodstone pendant fob seal.

Estimate: £700 - £1,000

Condition Report

Plaited neckchain - the boltring is in association. A central loop to connect the principal neckchain to the shorter length of chain is missing.

Agate fob - the intaglio is in good condition, some wear to the gold mount.

Bloodstone gilt metal seal - the watch key fitting is missing from the centre of the lower section, otherwise some wear to the high points which now show down to a base metal. The setting to the bloodstone is in association with the rest of the top of the seal.
