LOT 737

A diamond and citrine rectangular cluster ring, mounted with the rectangular cut citrine within a surround of fourteen circular cut diamonds, ring size approx G1/2.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

The ring is unmarked. Tests as white gold, probably better than 9ct.

The citrine is in good condition. The diamonds look to be fairly white stones, with a few inclusions noticeable under x10 magnification.

A section of the shank at the back has likely been replaced in the past, with two obvious join marks.

A couple of small splits where the shoulders on each side join the head of the ring.

Generally the ring is dirty and would benefit from a clean, especially the shank which is quite discoloured currently.

Suggested age - possibly 1930s/40s.

Citrine approx. 8.5mm x 7mm x 4.8mm

Diamonds possibly .03ct each.

Measurements limited by setting.
