Three unmounted cushion cut diamonds, dimensions of each approx $4.65 \text{mm} \times 4.95 \text{mm} \times 3.20 \text{mm}$, $4.20 \text{mm} \times 4.30 \text{mm} \times 3.20 \text{mm}$ and $3.90 \text{mm} \times 3.90 \text{mm} \times 2.60 \text{mm}$.

Condition Report

Unfortunately we are unable to provide a professional grading for the diamonds

Largest stone - a couple of white inclusions below a bezel and upper girdle facet on opposite sides of the stone, noticeable under x10 magnification. A few noticeable nicks to the girdle in one corner impacting on the outline of the stone when viewed face-up under x10.

Middle stone - has a white inclusion near the culet visible through the table at x10 magnification Smallest stone - dirt filled surface reaching inclusion to the side of the table, inclusion also near the culet visible through the table under x10 magnification

Largest stone is a whiter stone than the other two, the other two both look faintly yellow face up and side on.

Generally all three stones have rough girdles, ranging from extremely thin to thick with minor nicks in places.
