A late 19th century Burmese silver circular bowl, the body decorated in relief with panels of dancing figures within scrolling borders, height 11.5cm, together with two smaller Burmese silver bowls, heights 6.5cm and 5.5cm, total weight 791g.

### Condition Report

361. Larger bowl - in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Slight misshaping to rim. Engraved presentation inscription around the rim. Good crisp detail to decoration.

Mid-sized bowl - fairly good condition with typical surface wear, minor misshaping to rim and presentation inscription to cartouche.

Small bowl - generally ok, but some minor dents, some minor misshaping to rim and typical wear. Small dent to base.
