A Jaeger-LeCoultre 18ct gold rectangular cased lady's wristwatch with signed movement, the signed rectangular dial with black Arabic numerals and tapered hour markers, import mark Dublin 1951, case width 1.6cm, on an associated 9ct gold bracelet, the foldover clasp Birmingham 1960, with a few spare links, total weight 22.1g, together with an Edwardian silver cased keyless wind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, Chester 1902, case diameter 5cm.

Condition Report

Jaeger watch - in generally good condition with only typical minor surface scratches and wear to case and bracelet, the movement does not wind or run but does adjust smoothly. Dial with some minor scratches, wear and dirt spotting. The crystal with small crack to lower edge and minor stress cracks to corners
Silver pocket watch - small hairline crack to dial, minor dents to case back, typical surface scratches and wear. The watch is currently running and winds and adjusts smoothly, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
