An Omega silver cased keyless wind open-faced gentleman's pocket watch, the signed and jewelled lever movement detailed 'Omega Swiss Made 5654987', silver inner case, the signed enamelled dial with black Arabic numerals, subsidiary seconds and blued steel hands, Birmingham 1924, case diameter 4.9cm, together with a silver curb link watch Albert chain, Birmingham 1928, fitted with a silver T-bar and two silver swivels, total weight 153.6g, with a case.

Condition Report

The watch is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs.

Case with typical light surface scratches and wear and a couple of very minor surface dents to case back.

Some scratches around opening points.

Dial in good clean condition.

The curb link Albert chain also generally in good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear.

Leather case a little tired, scratched and worn.
