A George IV silver keywind open-faced pair cased gentleman's pocket watch, the gilt fusee movement with verge escapement, the backplate detailed 'Jn Howell Carmarthen 3701', the enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals, inner case London 1829, outer case London 1826, both by James Jackson II, outer case diameter 5.3cm.

Estimate: £60 - £100

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## Condition Report

The watch winds but does not run.

There is a hairline crack to the dial running from the centre to 12 o'clock.

Both cases with typical surface scratches and wear but both hinges are good.

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
