A Rolex Oyster Precision 9ct gold cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1955, the signed and jewelled movement numbered '04371', the signed cream dial with gilt Arabic hour numerals and centre seconds, crown to winding button, the milled screw case back with presentation inscription, numbered between the lugs '113666', the case back interior numbered '6422', import mark Glasgow 1955, case width 3.4cm, on a black leather strap.

Condition Report

1100. The watch is in generally good order with no significant damage. Case with typical surface scratches and wear. Case back with engraved inscription. Crown screws down tightly. Typical surface scratches to glass. Dial in generally good order, but some minor discolouration and some degrading and loss to luminous dot hour markers. The movement winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
